Flea Preparations – Cat

Frontline Spot On

Uses: The treatment and prevention of flea and tick infestations in the dog and part of the treatment strategy for flea allergic dermatitis.

Frontline spot on can be used from 8 weeks of age.

Administration: Hold the tube upright and tap the narrow part of the pipette to ensure contents are within the main body. Snap off the top of the pipette along the scored lines. Part the coat between the shoulder blades until the skin is visible. Place the tip of the pipette on the skin and squeeze gently to empty the contents onto the skin. This should preferably be done in 2 places; 1 at the base of the skull and the other 2 – 3cms back.

- It is important to apply the dose where the animal can't lick it off.
- Wash Hands after Use.
- Do not smoke/drink/eat during application.
- Ensure treated animals don't groom each other.

Monthly Treatment Required.

Frontline Spray

Dosage: In order to dampen the coat down to the skin apply 3-6 ml per kg body weight depending on the length of the hair. E.g. 6-12 pump applications per kg body weight of the 100ml preparation or 2-4 pump applications of the 250 or 500ml preparation.

Stronghold Spot On

This is a similar product to frontline and is applied in the same way. It also needs to be used monthly. It prevents:

- Roundworm
- Hookworm
- Biting Lice
- Sarcoptic Mange
- Ear Mites
- Heartworm

Stronghold is available to buy in packs of 3 or 6 pipettes. It is also available for kittens weighing less than 2.5kg. It can be used from 6 weeks of age.
