## Cat Vaccinations

Cats can be vaccinated against the following diseases:

- Cat Flu (Feline Herpes virus and Feline Calicivirus).
- Feline leukaemia Virus.
- Feline panleucopenia (Feline Infectious Enteritis).
- Feline Chlamydiosis.

**Feline Leukaemia** – This is a fatal disease that suppresses the cat's immune system.

**Feline Panleucopenia** – This is the feline version of canine parvovirus. It causes severe diarrhoea and dehydration often leading to death.

**Cat Flu** – This is a serious respiratory disease. It causes discharge from the eye and sneezing. It can lead to pneumonia.

## Kitten Vaccinations

These can start at 9 weeks of age. 2 vaccinations need to be given at least 3 weeks apart.

## Booster Vaccinations

It is important that annual booster vaccinations are given to the cat to maintain immunity. This is also a valuable time for a general health check with your veterinary surgeon.
