Dog Vaccinations

Dogs can be vaccinated against the following diseases:

- Distemper Virus
- Hepatitis
- Parvovirus
- Leptospirosis

Distemper – The nervous system is affected with this disease. It causes uncontrollable muscle twitching, vomiting and diarrhoea.

Hepatitis - The liver is affected with this disease. It can cause severe vomiting, diarrhoea and lethargy.

Parvovirus – This is a fatal disease often affecting young puppies. It causes haemorrhagic diarrhoea and vomiting.

Leptospirosis - The kidney and liver are affected in this disease. It causes vomiting and diarrhoea.

Puppy Vaccinations

These can start at 8 weeks of age. 2 Vaccinations need to be given at least 4 weeks apart.

Booster Vaccinations

It is important that annual booster vaccinations are given to the dog to maintain immunity. This is also a valuable time for a general health check with your veterinary surgeon.

Kennel Cough Vaccination

This is required by most boarding kennels now. It is given up the dog's nose. Annual boosters are required to maintain immunity.
